COST OF CHILD CARE



IN ARIZONA, a single parent pays 40% of their income for infant care. Married parents who live at the poverty line and have two children pay nearly 89% of their income for center care. The cost of child care for two children in Arizona is almost twice the annual cost of college tuition at a four year college.
