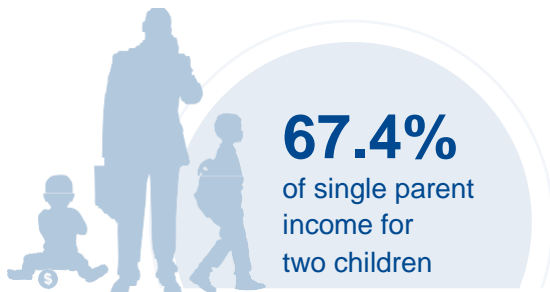
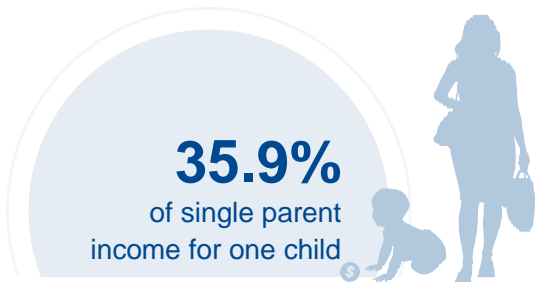




# NEBRASKA

## COST OF CHILD CARE



**IN NEBRASKA,** single parents pay 36% of their income for infant center care, and 67% of their income on center care for 2 children. Married parents of 2 children living at the poverty line pay 85% of their income for center care.
