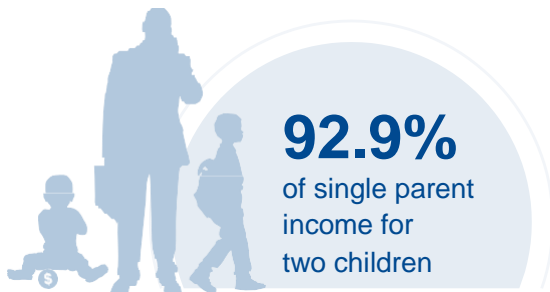
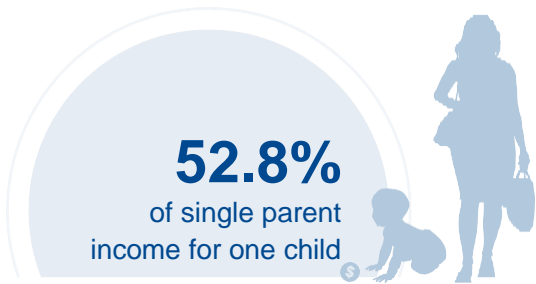

COST OF CHILD CARE



IN OREGON, single parents pay more than half of their income for infant center care, and 93% of their income for center care for 2 children. The cost of center care for 2 children in Oregon is more than twice the annual cost of college tuition at a four year college.
