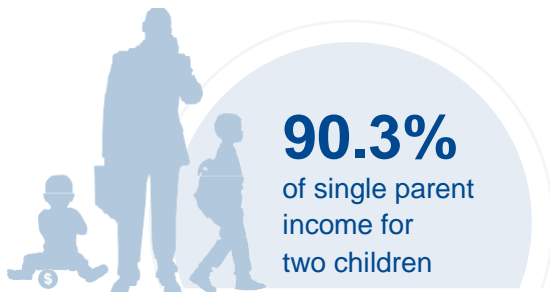
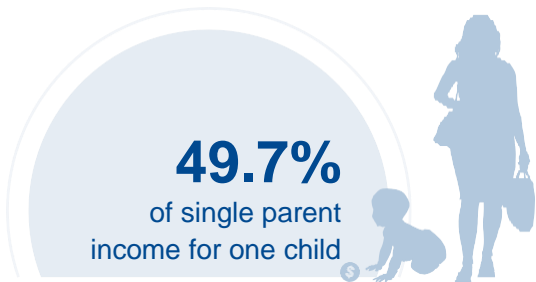




WISCONSIN

COST OF CHILD CARE



IN WISCONSIN, single parents pay half of their income for infant center care, and 90% of their income for center care for 2 children. Married parents of 2 children living at the poverty line pay 106% of their income for center care. The cost of infant care in Wisconsin is more than \$3,000 higher than the annual cost of college tuition at a four year college.
